PAL PAKS are designed to provide supplemental materials to teachers. These materials will enhance and/or extend the classroom and school library collections.

PAL PAKS utilize plastic tote boxes filled with a variety of library materials, generally 25-30 books and perhaps a few audio-visual products.



There are two types of PAL PAKS. The first type is a variety PAK of grade-level fiction titles. This type would be great to supplement a classroom library or for independent reading time. The second type consists of theme-based materials at grade level. For example, a class studying coral reefs could use a PAL PAK with that theme for independent or group research. This would be in addition to using their school library.
